From the Pastor's Desk



After celebrating the World Day of Prayer for Vocations last Sunday which stressed the need for more vocations to the priesthood and diaconate who will continue to attend to our spiritual needs and our journey towards God, this Sunday we have two events that clearly tells us why ordained ministers are important in our parish community. We have the Mass with Anointing for the sick and the closing of our Religious Education Program for our children for the school year 2015- 2016. These events take place within the mass.

The mass with anointing for the sick is a celebration of sacrament within a sacrament that only ordained ministers can preside by virtue of his ordination. Then we have the closing of our Religious Education Program for the School Year 2015-2016 which is very important in the faith formation of our children in order to become good Christians, not only in name, but also in living out our faith. Every year they go from one level to the next in order to progress in their understanding of faith. And for that we thank our dedicated and selfless teachers who continuously give their time, their effort and service freely all for the good of our children.

May God bless us all for what we do.
