Catechetical Sunday The third Sunday of September in the United States is celebrated as Catechetical Sunday in honor to acknowledge and commission those who are catechists. Today is Catechetical Sunday and this year, the Church will focus on the theme, *Prayer: The Faith Prayed*, which reminds catechists to nurture their prayer lives, which in turn allows for a deepening of their vocational call by attentively listening to God's voice dictating the grace of their lives.
