From the Pastor's Desk



Entering the Third Sunday of Advent we have the first intergenerational family night this Sunday, December 11th, from 6:30 – 8:00 P.M., in the Conference Center. Our topic will be the Season of Advent from FORMED.org - Session 3. If you were not able to watch it, don't worry because we will be showing it. You can bring your children, your family and friends as this is for everybody. All are welcome. In case you want to view the session ahead of our gathering, you can visit: formed.org, register with your name, and enter the parish code VNX4G6, there you can view all the programs, select Advent Session 3, and you will be able to watch it.

The following day, Monday, December 12th, we will not have mass in the morning. Instead, we will celebrate mass in the afternoon at 3:00 P.M. as a thanksgiving mass for my 10th year anniversary as a priest, and I extend this invitation to everyone. I know, for most of you, this will be difficult to attend since you will probably be at work, but you can still join me at the open house reception and that will be from 4:00 to 7:00 P.M., in our Fellowship Hall. The reason mass has been scheduled for 3:00 P.M. is the fact that most of the parishes in the diocese have their Advent Penance Services already scheduled. They cannot come to join us for evening mass nor for the early mass. With regards to our Advent Penance Service, the following is the schedule for our region:

History of St. Mary's Week 4

In 1902, the rectory was built by Pastor, H. McCullough. And in the year 1919, a service flag was dedicated in St. Mary's Church in honor of the forty-two young men of the parish serving their country, and the three young ladies serving as Red Cross Nurses. While Father S.J. Benson was pastor, the present school was built. Around that same time in 1923, the cemetery was moved from the site of the school and the remains moved to the site of our present cemetery off Freeport Road. The sisters of St. Joseph lived in a house at that time just across the street from the church, and in 1926, a new convent was built next to the church.
