Learning about Divine Mercy Week 8



The last two weeks have been about the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. We now know that it is an intercessory prayer that extends the Eucharistic offering of Jesus Christ and that we are praying to the Father that all that Jesus suffered for us might not be wasted, but might bring about our salvation. What we receive is the outpouring of all the graces needed for true repentance and conversion, even for a hardened sinner who cannot or will not pray for himself and this gives us a good hope! At the end of the chaplet, we pray a very old prayer that can be traced back to 400 A.D., "Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us, and on the whole world." It is the Greek phrase, Trisagion, which translates as "Thrice Holy." The Chaplet ends precisely where our merciful Savior wants to bring each and every one of us: into the embrace of the Blessed Trinity. "Eye has not seen, nor has ear heard, the things that God has prepared for those who love Him" (1 Cor 2:9)
