## From the Pastor's Desk



Thank you to each and every one of you who participated in the Mission Cooperative Plan last weekend. The generosity you have shared and extended will help out the Diocese of Daet, the recipient of this year's Mission Cooperative Plan, in their mission and evangelization.

Fr. Ben Cammayo, who represented the Diocese of Daet, shared with us that because the Diocese of Daet has only twenty-eight parishes and three quasi parishes serving the 93.5% Catholics of 583,000 population, many people who live in the villages have to walk several miles in order to attend Church for Sunday mass. Or the priest, assisted by the catechists, have to walk towards the village in order to celebrate mass, especially on their patronal feast. Mass baptisms are common during that celebration. The priest can have as many as sixty to one hundred infant baptisms in one day. So by the time the priest is finished with the mass baptisms, he is already exhausted and has to still walk back to the parish. He narrated that the priest has to bring an umbrella or a bamboo rattan as they walk towards the village in order to protect themselves from the snakes along the way. And because some parishes are in the coastal and remote

area, public transportations are not that many and the roads are not concrete. So the priest and the people have to walk or use boats as their mode of transportation. Most of the people are either fishermen or farmers.

And so, given that scenario, the assistance that we provide through the Mission Cooperative Plan will help the Diocese of Daet support their continuing efforts in their mission and evangelization, especially in constructing more worship sites in order to be more accessible for the people.

We may be far away from them, but our generosity makes a huge difference for them.

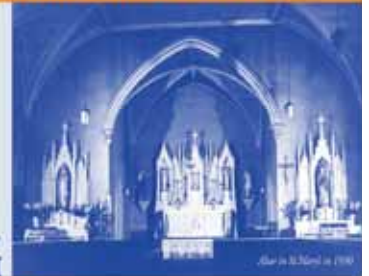
