#### History of St. Mary's-Week 2

Rev. Patrick O'Neil arrived in 1826 and was the first resident pastor. The following year the Pennsylvania Canal, which followed Kiskiminetas River to its mouth a mile above Freeport, was begun. The Catholic population was increasing, and Fr. O'Neil began planning the building of a church. He collected means from the farmers and laborers, and purchased a lot from Congressman Rogers for \$200.00. The contract for the church was let to a Protestant builder in 1827, who agreed to erect it for \$600.00. It was dedicated to St. Mary of the Nativity on September 8, 1831 by Bishop Kenrick, the first visit of a Bishop. The church was 34 feet in length and 28 feet in width, and had a gallery, with pews added a few years later. The congregation gradually increased with the growth of the town and in 1847, the Congregation then numbered four hundred souls.


