History of St. Mary's Week 6

In 1961, Msgr. Francis Karabinos built an addition to the school which included four rooms, a furnace room and new rest rooms at a cost of about \$120,000, with a new kitchen being added at a later time. There were no other major changes until 1987 following the collapse of a portion of the ceiling and roof occurring on Sunday, June 29, 1986. Miraculously, no one was in the church at that time. Under the direction of the pastor, Rev. Denis R. Sweeney, \$320,000 was quickly raised to complete the necessary repairs. During the renovation, air conditioning and carpeting were installed, the pews were repaired and upholstered, and the entire church painted.
