From the Pastor's Desk



A Lent to Remember!

After celebrating Mardi Gras in our parish, this coming Wednesday will be Ash Wednesday which marks the beginning of the Season of Lent. And by tradition, on this day we receive the ashes on our forehead from the minister while hearing the words of admonition to repent and believe in the gospel or to remember that we are dust and unto dust we shall return. This is a way to remember where we came from and the need to repent whenever we are aware of any sins committed, whether venial or mortal sins, in order to receive God's grace effectively.

During this season, we also observe some acts of piety and discipline like fasting, almsgiving and prayer as a way to make our observance more meaningful and to show our love for God in more concrete ways. We observe fasting and abstinence on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday while observing abstinence on All Fridays of Lent. Those who are fourteen years of age or older must abstain from meat on all Fridays of Lent, while those who are between the age of 18 - 59 must fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are sick, working in the hospital and who

engage in manual labor are exempted from fasting and abstinence.

Now I know some of you would like to look for other ways to deepen your spiritual journey and observance of the Lenten Season, so I invite you to join us for a four week, video-based study on <u>formed.org</u> to create a Lent to remember for our parish family. *Forgiven* is a beautiful presentation of the transforming power of Confession. No matter what you have done, no matter how long you have been away, Jesus is waiting for you in the Sacrament of Reconciliation!


