# STRENGTHS AND WEAKNESSES

Well, we have turned the calendar to February now, and after we celebrate our Mardi Gras next weekend, we will celebrate Ash Wednesday and quickly move into the season of Lent and the return of our pastor.

Continuing with the discussion of our neighborhood listening sessions, last week we summarized the high points as well as the low points in the history of our parish that many of you pointed out at the various sessions. Now it is time to recap the strengths and weaknesses that surfaced at our various meetings.

One prevalent item that was brought out repeatedly as a strength was the welcoming and open atmosphere that permeates our liturgies. The enthusiasm mentioned is illustrated in our greeter program (which we hope to strengthen with more volunteers), the readiness of members to always step forward when we need assistance at a liturgy or function and the introduction of some new ministries and opportunities for involvement. Also identified as strengths are our Holy Week liturgies, the children's *Breaking Open the Word* at the 8:30 Mass on Sundays, the online program "Formed", vacation bible camp, Homebound Ministry and our Teen Ministry Program. The reintroduction of our annual parish picnic as well as our Mardi Gras celebration coming up next weekend were also seen as strong points. People also felt that we have good financial checkpoints in place and that our pastoral and finance councils provide a level of financial transparency that is very important in today's often skeptical world. The development of our Rosary Garden was seen as a spiritual asset as well as the efforts of our Christian Mothers organization. Finally, the leadership provided by Father Ron and the various priests that have preceded him here at St. Mary's have certainly provided the best possible strength to our parish family.

We obviously cannot avoid a discussion of some potential weaknesses that exist. The parking lot and the issues that surround tandem parking were a major point of discussion, but some new signs as a result of these listening sessions has help the situation some. If anyone would like to volunteer to be a parking lot greeter, please see Father Ron upon his return. Although we have new members each year, our attendance is stable. We need a better way to identify and address parishioners who are leaving our family before it is too late to reverse the decision. Low attendance at First Friday Adoration/Benediction, lack of retreats and days of recollection, the need for more greeters and ushers, and the need to involve younger members of our congregation in volunteer activities were also identified as weaknesses. While our teen ministry is seen as a strength, the lack of programs for young adults in their 20's and 30's was seen as a definite weakness. The struggle to recruit more choir members as well as the development of a more vibrant music program in general were also seen as weak points. And of course, the need for clearances and their effect on the number of volunteers was voiced repeatedly.

In our final recap next week, Beth and I will recap where we go from here. What have you, our fellow members, identified as the necessary steps to take in the near future as well as in the long term to continue to strengthen and build our parish family at St. Mary's. So, stay tuned for our final communication with you next week.

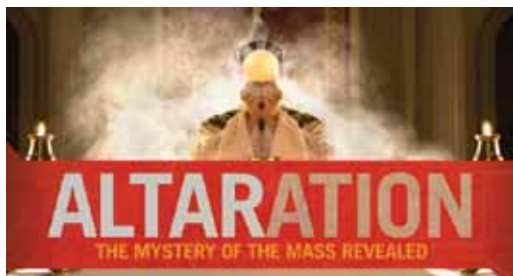

When the priest asks you to exchange the sign of peace during this Mass, simply turn to the person next to you, and without contact, say "Peace be with you" and respond with the words, "And also with you."
